Hello and Welcome!

Although the precise origins are uncertain, for centuries Catholics have been dedicating out month of May to Mary, the Mother of Our Lord: with devotional prayers and even processions as the month coincides with Spring and new birth. The devotional prayers are often accompanied by specific requests for Mary's intercession with God. Setting aside the month for Mary has been ratified by two popes. In 1954, Pope Pius XI proclaimed the Queenship of Mary through his encyclical, *Ad Caeli Reginam*. It was the first time a pope had given credit to Mary for her role in the Redemption with her son. In 1965, Pope Paul VI in *Mense Maio* wrote that May should be a time for special prayers for peace and devotion to Mary Mother of God. Our late, much loved, Pope Francis had a great devotion to Our Lady and once wrote these beautiful words, "Let us learn from the strong and helpful faith of our Mother Mary, in order to become living signs of God's mercy." I commend everyone to pray the rosary, or recite other Marian devotions, alone or even better, with others, especially during this month. At the end of Mass, we will sing a simple anthem or short hymn of praise in honour of Our Lady.
